Digital portfolio submission

Notre Dame's Art Department is seeking scholars who have potential in and a genuine passion for Art and Design. In order to demonstrate this, candidates are requested to submit a creative set of work of up to 10 slides by email to Mrs Gemma Stubberfield at <u>gstubberfield@notredame.co.uk</u> on or before Monday 9th January 2023.

- The portfolio could include original paintings, drawings, collage, print-making, textiles, photographs and other craft samples.
- The work can include art ideas produced at home as well and at school.
- The work should demonstrate the candidate's knowledge of observational drawing, painting and design ideas.
- It should also demonstrate the use of colour and ability to work with a variety of materials.
- Sculptures and framed pictures unfortunately can't be accepted, however photographs of such artwork presented as part of the portfolio are welcome.

Please make sure that all attachments are clearly labelled.

Practical assessment

Following an evaluation of all submissions, candidates may be invited to the practical assessment. During the assessment, candidates will be required to produce an observational drawing within one hour. They will also have one hour to respond to a piece of artwork in colour. This will be explained in full on the day. All materials and subject matter will be provided.
