SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic Scholarships

Academic Scholarships in the Sixth Form are awarded based on the results of the Scholarship examination. The examination will take place on **Thursday 14 November 2019 between 2:00pm – 4:00pm**. The paper will assess logic, comprehension and thinking skills and is not subject specific. The examination will ask the student to respond to and assess the relative merits of evidence, make informed and evaluated decisions and reach justifiable conclusions. The students will be able to draw on a range of skills and experiences from the varied elements of their GCSE courses.

Applications must be submitted by **Thursday 7 November 2019**.

If you are successful in attaining an Academic Scholarship the value of the award is up to 25% of fees for two years, subject to an annual review.

Art & Design, Drama, Music, or Sport Scholarships

In order to apply for one of these awards, you will need to have excellent potential to achieve a high grade in the chosen subject at A Level.

Applications must be submitted by **Thursday 7th November 2019**.

Scholarship assessments will take place **during the week of 11th November 2019**.

For Art & Design - an interview during which students will be asked to show a portfolio of work (which can be examination pieces if they wish) which must be submitted to Head of Subject by **7th November**

For Music – a performance, aural test and an interview. Students are asked to prepare an audition lasting between 10 and 15 minutes on their first (and second if applicable) instrument. Candidates with suitable singing experience may choose to demonstrate their vocal ability. Students will be asked to perform unaccompanied or to submit music for accompaniment upon application by **7th November**. Those holding the award will be expected to make a strong contribution to the musical life of the school. All music scholars with suitable voices will be expected to complement their instrumental studies and participation in school orchestra with membership of the school choir and other smaller ensembles as directed by the Head of Music.

For Drama - an interview followed by the student's performance of two contrasting audition monologues, each of no more than three minutes in length, one of which should be a period text.

For Sport – there will be a short interview, a fitness assessment and then an observed practical in netball.

If you are successful in attaining one of these awards, the value of the award is up to 25% of fees for two years, subject to an annual review.
