Sixth Form Scholarships and Assessments

We are delighted to receive applications from girls in Year 11 for Academic, Art, Drama, Music and Sport Sixth Form Scholarships. These are awarded following Scholarship Assessments which take place in **mid-November 2021** for girls joining ND6 in 2022. The value of these awards is up to 25% of fees for two years, subject to an annual review. The closing date for applications, using the standard Registration Form and Sixth Form Subjects Form, is **Friday 5th November 2021**.

Academic Scholarships

Academic Scholarships in the Sixth Form are awarded based on the results of the Scholarship examination. The examination will take place in the middle of November. The paper will assess logic, comprehension and thinking skills and is not subject specific. The examination will ask the student to respond to and assess the relative merits of evidence, make informed and evaluated decisions and reach justifiable conclusions. The students will be able to draw on a range of skills and experiences from the varied elements of their GCSE courses.

Art & Design, Drama, Music, or Sport Scholarships

In order to apply for one of these awards, you will need to have excellent potential to achieve a high grade in the chosen subject at A Level.

For Art & Design – an interview during which students will be asked to show a portfolio of work (which can be examination pieces if they wish – art and/or textiles) which must be submitted to Head of Subject by **5th November**.

For Music – a performance, aural test and an interview. Students are asked to prepare an audition lasting between 10 and 15 minutes on their first (and second if applicable) instrument. Candidates with suitable singing experience may choose to demonstrate their vocal ability. Students will be asked to perform unaccompanied or to submit music for accompaniment upon application by **5th November**. Those holding the award will be expected to make a strong contribution to the musical life of the school. All music scholars with suitable voices will be expected to complement their instrumental studies and participation in school orchestra with membership of the school choir and other smaller ensembles as directed by the Head of Music.

For Drama – an interview followed by the student's performance of two contrasting audition monologues, each of no more than three minutes in length, one of which should be a period text. Students are also invited to submit a written review, not exceeding 1,000 words, of a production they have seen at any time (live theatre production or a theatre production viewed via an online source). The review might cover the acting performances, design ideas and directorial elements.

For Sport – there will be a short interview followed by an observed practical.
